How to make a dental dam from condom!

It is possible to pass a sexually transmitted infection to a partner through oral-genital or oral-anal sex. A dental dam can be effective in reducing this risk!

A dental dam is a barrier between a person's mouth and another person's genitals. Many people use them during oral sex.

- Check expiration date of the condom
- Check to see there is a bubble of air in the package (to know it hasn't been pierced). If no bubble – get a new condom!
- Open the package (not with your teeth!) and take out the condom
- 4. Grab some scissors and cut the tip off the condom
- 5. Cut through the ring of the condom
- Unroll it! You now have yourself a dental dam. Add some flavoured lube if you like, and lay it over your/your partner's anus or vulva before having oral sex.
